COLLEGE OPENING TIMES

The College is normally empty outside of teaching times so please do contact us before setting out to see us if you are meeting outside of normal lesson times. These times are:

For daytime courses: 09:00 – 16:30 (Level 4 Diploma)

For morning courses: 09:30 – 12:30

For evening courses: 18:05 – 21:05

DIRECTIONS

Whatever mode of transport you choose to get to us, you will probably end the last part of your journey under your own steam. To navigate to us the following information may be helpful:

If you are attending a course the college door will be open approximately half an hour before the course start time (**see above**). Outside of these times (if you are meeting us or coming for an out of class tutorial for example), please ring the doorbell and we will let you in.

ARRIVING ON FOOT OR BIKE

Once you arrive at the college, there is plenty of space to leave your bike on the ground floor. Please note that we cannot be responsible for the security of any bikes or accessories left on the premises; but you are more welcome to leave your bike “under the stairs”.

At the top of the stairs, outside of the Yalom Room – our main training room – we have a shoe rack for you to leave your shoes; and in the Bowie Room there are shelves for bags, coats etc.

ARRIVING BY TRAIN

Newton Abbot Railway Station is half a mile (approximately 11 minutes’ walk) from the College and is served by fairly regular trains from both Plymouth, Exeter and Torbay. For more details you may find the following website useful: <https://www.thetrainline.com/>

On leaving the station you have a choice of routes with the slightly more direct route being to turn right and head along Queen’s Street until you reach Lloyd’s Bank, where you turn left until you get to the end of Union Street (another left turn between HSBC and Barclay’s Banks).

ARRIVING BY BUS

Newton Abbot Bus Station is three minute’s walk from the College. It is located adjacent to the Multi Storey Car Park. You can access the college either through the Market or by walking along Sherborne Road with the car park on your left and turning right towards Lloyd’s Bank.



ARRIVING BY CAR

If you are arriving by car and want to park outside the college you will need to drive along the A381.

From the direction of **Bovey Tracey** or **Totnes**

Take the A381 at the A382/Totnes Road interchange near Asda (heading towards Torquay). Follow the road until on your left you see “Ye Olde Cider Bar” turn left onto Union Street – follow the road round and you will see us on the right hand side.

From the direction of **Exeter** or **Paignton**

Take the A381 at the Penn inn roundabout. Follow signs for Totnes until you see “Ye Olde Cider Bar” on your right, turn right onto Union Street – follow the road round and you will see us on the right hand side.

There is on-street parking outside the college in Union Street or just around the corner on Queen Street. Both are chargeable between 09:00 & 18:00. If these places are full or you are attending a course running through the day you have a choice of 8 car parks within a fifteen-minute walk of the college – some are only short stay.

The most convenient, Halcyon Road and the Multi Storey Car Parks, are both three to five minute’s walk away; the multi storey is a longer stay option and both are free from 18:00. We will start all evening courses as 18:05 to allow you to park free of charge!

If you don’t like the idea of the multi-storey, the Cricket Field Car Park is a 7 minute walk along the River Lemon.
